With the completion of additional general education classes beyond your registered apprenticeship training, students can earn an **Associate of Applied Science Transfer (AAS-T) degree in Multi-Occupational Trades (MOT)** from South Seattle College to open up future career advancement opportunities and increased earning power.

What type of degree will I earn?

Upon satisfying all degree requirements, you will apply to graduate and be awarded an Associate of Applied Science-Transfer (AAS-T) degree in Multi-Occupational Trades.

Apprenticeship Requirements:

- Completion of a registered apprenticeship program of at least 6,000 hours certified by the Registered Apprenticeship Committee
- Completion of at least 450 hours of related training certified by the Registered Apprenticeship Committee

General Education Requirements:

- 5 Credits of Written Communication: ENGL& 101 English Composition 1
- 5 credits of Oral Communication: CMST& 220 Public Speaking
- 5 credits of Quantitative Reasoning: MATH & 107 Math in Society
- 5 credits of Social Science: PSYC& 100 General Psychology OR SOC& 101 - Introduction to Sociology
